KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 87-7

APPROPRIATING \$25,000 TO THE LEGAL DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the sum of \$55,000 was appropriated to the legal department for contract services which include expert witnesses and legal services; and

WHEREAS, these funds have been expended for those purposes and the account has an unencumbered balance of \$16,561 as of January 5, 1987; and

WHEREAS, those unencumbered funds are budgeted for computerized research, paralegal and law clerk assistance in handling delinquent tax cases and other suits; and

WHEREAS, the borough suit against the state on school funding will involve the use of experts to prepare for trial and motions; and

WHEREAS, this case is being scheduled for trial; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that \$25,000 will be necessary to obtain services of experts;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$25,000 is appropriated from the unappropriated fund balance to the Legal Department Contract Services Account #100-113010-43011.

Section 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
