KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 88-9

AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF VARIOUS GRANTS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA AND APPROPRIATING \$1,045,000 TO THE VARIOUS PROJECT ACCOUNTS.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has appropriated \$1,045,000 for grants to the Kenai Peninsula Borough by HB 512 for various projects within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, \$647,000 is allocated to Public Works Roads/Waste Disposal Repair and Upgrade; and

WHEREAS, \$75,000 is allocated to the Anchor Point Fire Station; and

WHEREAS, \$23,000 is allocated to the Bear Creek Garage Construction; and

WHEREAS, \$75,000 is allocated to the Nikiski Fire Service Area for firehall renovation; and

WHEREAS, \$225,000 is allocated to the Nikiski Pedestrian Safety;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to accept these grants and that appropriations be made to the following accounts:

400.710801.49999.88000	Nikiski Pedestrian Safety	\$225,000

Section 2. That Section 4 CS for House bill 512 states the unexpended and unobligated balances of the appropriations made in this act lapse into the State of Alaska general fund October 30, 1989. The appropriations made by this ordinance are subject to this restriction.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
