WHEREAS, \$75,000 is allocated to the Nikiski Fire Service Area for firehall renovation; and

WHEREAS, \$225,000 is allocated to the Nikiski Pedestrian Safety;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the Mayor is authorized to accept these grants and that appropriations be made to the following accounts:
