ORDINANCE 88-15

AMENDING KPB 2.08.080 TO PROVIDE THAT AN ASSEMBLY AGENDA ITEM THAT HAS BEEN TABLED MAY NOT BE REMOVED FROM THE TABLE FOR CONSIDERATION.

WHEREAS, Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure provides that an item that is tabled by the assembly may be removed from the table unless the assembly has established a practice or a separate rule that such tabled items may not be removed from the table; and

WHEREAS, the assembly has established a practice that an item which has been tabled may not be removed from the table for further consideration; and

WHEREAS, it is good practice to codify procedural rules;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB 2.08.080 is amended to read as follows:

2.08.080 Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure--Adopted--Scope--Exception. A. The borough assembly adopts as its rules of procedure Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure.

B. An item of business that has been laid on the table pursuant to Chapter 34 of Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure, may not be removed from the table and laying a matter on the table shall be considered as a final unfavorable disposition of the matter.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
