KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 88-18

AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF FUNDS FROM THE VETERANS ADMINISTRATION AND APPROPRIATING MATCHING MONIES FOR THE VETERANS JOB TRAINING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Veteran's Job Training (VJT) program offers employers who hire VJT eligible veterans reimbursement for one-half the salary of those employees for up to nine months of employment; and

WHEREAS, the Veterans Administration has approved the Kenai Peninsula Borough's hiring of up to twelve VJT eligible employees; and

WHEREAS, this program will benefit both the Borough and area veterans; and

WHEREAS, matching monies are available in the Maintenance Department's fiscal year 1987/88 budget;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to accept the grant funds from the Veterans Administration.

Section 2. That an appropriation is established for the employment of the VJT eligible veterans in the following accounts:

Section 3. That \$29,905 be transferred to account number 100.410010.47270, Transfer to Maintenance Grant fund, from the following accounts:

Regular Wages	100.410010.40110	\$ 20,000.00
Temporary Wages	100.410010.40120	6,000.00
FICA	100.410010.40210	3,905.00
TOTAL		<u>\$ 29,905.00</u>


and that these funds be transferred to the Maintenance Grant fund estimated revenue account 270.38100.

Section 4. That an estimated revenue account, 270.33310, in the amount of \$26,000 be established in the Maintenance Grant Fund to record the reimbursement from the Veterans Administration.

Section 5. That the employees hired under this program be paid from the Maintenance Grant Fund.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
