KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 88-24 (SUBSTITUTE)

ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND REGIONAL AFFAIRS, FOR ENERGY CONSERVATION PROJECTS AT KENAI CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL, KENAI CENTRAL HIGH VOCATIONAL BUILDING, AND NIKISKI ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, the Technical Assistance Study, Phase II, is completed, and Resolution 88-11 was passed by the Borough Assembly approving the application for energy conservation grant and matching funds for projects at Kenai Central High School, Kenai Central High Vocational Building, and Nikiski Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Community and Regional Affairs Department, has allocated funds for the energy conservation of Kenai school projects in the amount of \$130,053; and

WHEREAS, the local required match of \$132,054 will be provided from the budget account number 400.780500.49126.88001 authorized by Resolution 88-11;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Borough Assembly hereby accepts and authorizes the Mayor to execute grant agreements with the State of Alaska, Department of Community and Regional Affairs, in the amount of \$130,053 for a total of \$260,107 for the various schools listed above.

Section 2. That \$130,054 authorized for this project by the Borough Assembly in Resolution 88-11 be transferred to the Maintenance Grant Fund to account number 270.38400.

Section 3. That \$260,107 be appropriated to the following accounts for the Energy Conservation Grant:
