KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 88-25

PROVIDING FOR ELECTION OF THE SCHOOL BOARD BY DESIGNATED SEATS WITH EACH SEAT VOTED ON IN THE ENTIRE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, all school board candidates currently run in a single race with those receiving the greatest number of votes in excess of 40% of the ballots cast being elected; and

WHEREAS, the school board requested the assembly to establish a plan for election of board members by designated seats within a district; and

WHEREAS, the assembly election districts are based upon a 16 seat body and their use for school elections would result in an imbalanced representation for the 7 member school board; and

WHEREAS, adoption of a districting plan could not be implemented until the school board elections of October 1989; and

WHEREAS, that date is only one year from the 1990 census which would almost certainly cause changes to any election districts created at this time; and

WHEREAS, despite the problems with establishing election districts, the assembly believes it to be desirable to provide that school board members be elected to a specific seat instead of an open election with all candidates running against each other;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding a new section to be numbered KPB 4.10.035 which shall read as follows:

4.10.035 School board--Election by seats. The school board shall consist of seven (7) seats lettered A through G. Candidates for the school board shall file for a designated seat and election to that seat will be from votes cast in the race for that seat. The ballot shall identify the seat and all candidates for that seat.

 $\underline{\text{Section 2}}$. That to establish the seats initially, the borough clerk shall assign a seat designation to each of the incumbents on the school board. Upon expiration of the incum-

bent's term of office, the seat shall be filled in accordance with KPB 4.10.035 until all seats are filled by a person elected to that seat. No term of an incumbent is to be shortened; however, in the event of a vacancy before a term has expired any election to fill the vacancy shall be by election to the designated seat.

 $\underline{\text{Section 3}}.$ That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
