ORDINANCE 88-28

ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA OF \$90,800 FOR NIKISKI SCHOOL PEDESTRIAN WALKWAYS.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, by HB 543, has appropriated \$90,800 for a grant to the Kenai Peninsula Borough for Nikiski School pedestrian walks;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to accept this grant, and that the grant amount of \$90,800 be appropriated to account: 400.710801.49999.8800 for Nikiski School Pedestrian Walkways.

Section 2. That the appropriation made in Section 1 of this ordinance is subject to Section 4CS of House Bill 543, states that the unexpended and unobligated balance of the appropriation made in this act lapses into the State of Alaska General Fund on October 20, 1989.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
