ORDINANCE 88-53

ESTABLISHING AN ADVISORY PLANNING COMMISSION IN THE COMMUNITY OF ANCHOR POINT

WHEREAS, the borough exercises all planning and zoning powers within the borough outside of cities; and

WHEREAS, the borough has delegated zoning powers within cities of the borough at their request to deal with matters of local concern; and

WHEREAS, the borough has established advisory planning commissions within the communities of Cooper Landing, Hope, and Moose Pass to advise the Borough Planning Commission on matters of local concern; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for a local advisory planning commission in the Anchor Point community to allow and encourage local participation in planning and zoning matters;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the borough code is amended by enactment of a new KPB 21.02.035 to read as follows:


21.02.035 Anchor Point Advisory Planning Commission. An advisory planning commission is established for the community of the borough known as Anchor Point with boundaries identical to those of the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area.


Section 2. That the Anchor Point Advisory Planning Commission is hereby empowered and authorized to act in accordance with the provisions of KPB 21.02 in advising the Borough Planning Commission on planning and zoning matters affecting that community.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
