ORDINANCE NO. 89-3

EXTENDING THE TIME LIMIT FOR PURCHASE OF FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT  
FOR SKYVIEW HIGH SCHOOL

WHEREAS, KPB 1.20.025 requires that all purchases of new furniture and equipment from the school bond funds shall be completed within 24 months after the school facility has been turned over to the borough for beneficial occupancy; and

WHEREAS, the opening of Skyview High School was delayed by a year and the school board considered it inappropriate to purchase equipment and furniture for the facility that would not be in operation until such time as it would be opened; and


WHEREAS, the time limit for purchasing the furniture and equipment will be reached in Spring of 1990 and should be moved back to account for the delay in opening;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That notwithstanding the provisions of KPB 1.20.025 the time for purchase of new furniture and equipment for the Skyview High School from the project bond funds is extended to June 1, 1991.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
