ORDINANCE 89-14

APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR REMOVAL, TESTING AND PROTECTION OF UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS AND ESTABLISHING THE STORAGE TANK CLEANUP FUND

WHEREAS, federal laws mandate that underground storage tanks receive rigorous inspection; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has about 45 underground storage tanks; and

WHEREAS, 9 of these tanks are considered abandoned and should be removed; and

WHEREAS, eight additional tanks have been identified as tanks requiring action by December 1989; and

WHEREAS, the removal, inspection and spill protection measures and attendant work for these 17 tanks is estimated to cost \$125,500; and

WHEREAS, the initial requirements for inspection, spill protection and removal will be on a schedule through 1993 for the remaining tanks with additional requirements imposed through 1998; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to account for these ongoing activities in a separate fund;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a new special revenue fund entitled "Underground Storage Tank Removal & Upgrade Fund" is hereby created.

Section 2. That the amount of \$125,500 is appropriated to account 100-949010-47265 from the General Fund balance and the amount is transferred to the Underground Storage Tank Removal & Upgrade Fund.


Section 3. That the amount of \$125,500 is appropriated to account 265-325060-49999 in the Underground Storage Tank Removal & Upgrade Fund.

Section 4. That the mayor is authorized to expend these funds for testing, removal, replacement and upgrade of exist-

ing borough tanks in accordance with the requirements of the federal laws governing underground storage tanks.

Section 5. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
