KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 89-45

APPROPRIATING \$150,000 FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Borough initiated a program to inspect, upgrade and remove underground storage tanks in accordance with Federal underground storage tank laws; and

WHEREAS, initially \$125,000 was appropriated to fund the program needs for the calendar year 1989; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has completed much of its 1989 work program for inspection and removal; and

WHEREAS, there are approximately 850 tons of hydrocarbon contaminated soil that were removed in connection with the work and this material must be disposed of in a proper fashion; and

WHEREAS, the Borough proposes use of a large quantity of the material in making asphalt and paving parking areas, driveways, and roadways as a cost-effective means of final disposition of this material; and

WHEREAS, the tanks at Susan B. English School in Seldovia have leaks which require more extensive clean up than originally anticipated; and

WHEREAS, the best current estimate for additional funds for the 1989 work and clean up would be an additional \$150,000;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.


Section 1. That the sum of \$150,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the leaking underground storage tank project account, No. 265-325060-49999.

Section 2. That these funds be utilized for carrying out the purposes of that program, including but not limited to, inspection, testing, removal and replacement of underground storage tanks, and associated clean up.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
