ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF ADVISORY PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS

WHEREAS, the current procedure for notification of vacancies for advisory planning commission appointment is unclear;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

<u>Section 1</u>. That KPB 21.01.050 is hereby amended as follows: 21.02.050 Membership. A. The advisory planning commissions shall consist of not more than 7 members [WHO] <u>, each of whom are</u> <u>qualified voters of the borough, and</u> reside within the respective community [WHO] <u>. They</u> shall be appointed by the mayor, with the consent of the assembly, to serve for a 3-year term. Nominations may be submitted to the mayor by the nonprofit community organizations within the individual communities, and by any other resident who may wish to place a name in nomination.

B. The commission shall post notice of a commission vacancy in a prominent place within the community, i.e., post office, for a 30 day period after the commission declares the vacancy or 30 days before the term expires.

<u>Section 2</u>. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
