KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 89-58

APPROPRIATING ADVANCE FUNDING OF \$165,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND BALANCE TO PROCEED WITH THE DESIGN OF THE SEWARD TRANSFER FACILITY, CLOSURE OF PRESENT LANDFILL AND DIKE EXTENSION

WHEREAS, the voters of the Kenai Peninsula Borough approved issuance of bonds in the amount of \$4,662,000 for improvements at the Seward and Soldotna Landfills; and

WHEREAS, the need exists to expedite engineering on the dike and transfer site; and

WHEREAS, these funds are needed prior to the sale of bonds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$165,000 is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated fund balance of the Kenai Peninsula Borough General Fund for the purpose of design development for the Seward transfer facility, closure of present landfill and dike extension.

Section 2. That the mayor is hereby authorized to utilize these funds for the design phases for the above Seward Landfill projects and that these funds are assigned to the Seward Landfill capital improvement account 411-321050-49999-89BON.

Section 3. That this advance of funds authorized by this ordinance shall be returned to the General Fund of the Kenai Peninsula Borough from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds.

Section 4. That the mayor is authorized to proceed with the award of survey, testing and design of these facilities.

Section 5. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
