## ORDINANCE 89-61

CLASSIFYING BOROUGH PATENTED LAND FOR DISPOSAL UNDER LEASE WITH OPTION TO PURCHASE

WHEREAS, the borough has received patent to Government Lot 22, Section 25, Township 4 North, Range 12 West, Seward Meridian, a bluff lot overlooking Cook Inlet, just north of Kasilof, pursuant to the Municipal Entitlement Act; and

WHEREAS, Randy and Rose Renner have used the property for some years for penning and grazing livestock and wish to continue to use the property for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, on October 23, 1989, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission denied a request for a long term grazing permit on said property; and

WHEREAS, the Renners, subsequent to the planning commission action, have verbally requested they be given the opportunity to lease the property with an option to purchase; and

WHEREAS, the land should be classified for disposal and a preference given to the Renners for purchase;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

<u>Section 1</u>. That Government Lot 22, Section 25, Township 4 North, Range 12 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska containing 3.09 acres more or less hereby be classified as disposal.

<u>Section 2</u>. That the mayor is authorized to sign such documents necessary to effectuate a five year lease with option to purchase to Randy and Rose Renner at the then current year's assessed value. The lease/purchase agreements shall substantially be the same as those attached to this ordinance.

<u>Section 3</u>. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
