KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 90-1

APPROPRIATING \$89,200 FOR A GRANT FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA TO SUPPLEMENT BOROUGH FUNDING FOR LOCAL SENIOR CITIZEN PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly adopted Resolution 90-2 authorizing application and acceptance of a grant from the Alaska Legislature in the amount of \$89,200 for the borough's senior citizen program; and

WHEREAS, the appropriation needs to be made to the individual senior citizen groups based on Ordinance 86-27;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That \$89,200 in grant funds received from the State of Alaska for senior citizen programs is appropriated and allocated to the following accounts for each senior citizen group:


