ORDINANCE 90-2

AMENDING ORDINANCE 89-22 TO INCREASE THE APPROPRIATION BY \$1,831,000 FOR WINTER AND SPRING OIL SPILL RESPONSE ACTIVITIES UNDER A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMEN-TAL CONSERVATION

WHEREAS, the Assembly appropriated up to \$3,000,000 for oil spill response by Ordinance 89-22 subject to agreements for reimbursement of expenditures; and

WHEREAS, agreements for reimbursement in accordance with that ordinance have been entered and oil spill response activities undertaken; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough and the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation have entered an agreement for winter and spring oil spill response activities with reimbursement for up to \$1,831,000; and

WHEREAS, the appropriation made by Ordinance 89-22 needs to be increased by that amount;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the appropriation of \$3,000,000 made by Ordinance 89-22 is hereby increased by \$1,831,000 for a total appropriation for oil spill response activities due to the Exxon Valdez spill of \$4,831,000.

Section 2. That all costs and expenses under the new reimbursement agreement and this appropriation for Winter and Spring response be charged against Account 261-112053-49999-RESPON.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
