EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 90-5

ACCEPTING EMERGENCY RELIEF FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA IN THE AMOUNT OF \$150,000 AND APPROPRIATING THOSE FUNDS FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENDITURES ASSOCIATED WITH THE ERUPTION OF REDOUBT VOLCANO

WHEREAS, The eruption of Redoubt Volcano has required the Borough to replace filters, provide 24-hour communications, and encapsulate volcanic ash; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State and the Mayor of the Kenai Peninsula Borough have declared a state of emergency in the areas within the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough may be eligible for reimbursement from the State of Alaska for disaster relief in the estimated amount of \$150,000; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate these funds for reimbursement of costs associated with Redoubt Volcano eruptions;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to receive emergency funds from the State of Alaska in the estimated amount of \$150,000.



Section 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough appropriates \$150,000 in the disaster relief fund from account #260.27910 to the disaster relief fund contingency account (260.112056.49999.Redbt) to be expended in accordance with State regulations.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
