ORDINANCE 90-13

AMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE PROVISIONS REGARDING ASSEMBLY MEMBERS' CAR ALLOWANCE COMPENSATION

WHEREAS, paragraph 2.12.080 of the borough code governs compensation for assembly members; and

WHEREAS, the current provisions allow for car allowance to reimburse assembly members for personal car use; and

WHEREAS, assembly members are reimbursed at a specific mileage rate for authorized borough business trips; and

WHEREAS, the most publicly misunderstood benefit that assembly members receive is the car allowance;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That assembly members shall no longer be paid car allowance as currently provided under KPB 2.12.080 B.

Section 2. That KPB 2.12.080 B. is amended to read as follows:

2.12.080 B. Assembly members [SHALL RECEIVE AN ALLOWANCE OF \$150.00 PER MONTH FOR USE OF THE PERSONAL AUTOMOBILE ON BOROUGH BUSINESS, AND] shall be reimbursed for mileage recorded on authorized borough business trips at the rate of \$.45 per mile.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
