ORDINANCE 90-30

APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE CT-SCAN ADDITION TO THE CENTRAL PENINSULA GENERAL HOSPITAL

WHEREAS, during preparation for higher voltage electrical service for the CT-Scan equipment, it was discovered that the higher voltage would also be needed for new X-ray equipment, and this extra service was incorporated into this project; and

WHEREAS, proposed alternates for the darkroom and viewroom have become critical and need to be included in the project; and

WHEREAS, the increased cost due to these items was estimated at \$30,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the bids exceed the currently appropriated sums and a further \$100,000.00 needs to be appropriated to complete this project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$138,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Central Peninsula General Hospital's unappropriated capital funds account to Account 490-811010-90501 for the CT-Scan facility addition project for the Central Peninsula General Hospital.

- Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to utilize these funds for the construction of the above CT-Scan Addition project, and all expenditures will be charged against the project account.
- <u>Section 3</u>. That unused portions of funds appropriated for this project shall be returned to the Central Peninsula General Hospital's unappropriated capital funds account upon completion of the project.
- Section 4. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with the award of a construction contract for the CT-Scan Facility.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
