ORDINANCE 90-30

APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE CT-SCAN ADDITION TO THE CENTRAL PENINSULA GENERAL HOSPITAL

WHEREAS, during preparation for higher voltage electrical service for the CT-Scan equipment, it was discovered that the higher voltage would also be needed for new X-ray equipment, and this extra service was incorporated into this project; and

WHEREAS, proposed alternates for the darkroom and viewroom have become critical and need to be included in the project; and

WHEREAS, the increased cost due to these items was estimated at \$30,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the bids exceed the currently appropriated sums and a further \$100,000.00 needs to be appropriated to complete this project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$138,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Central Peninsula General Hospital's unappropriated capital funds account to Account 490-811010-90501 for the CT-Scan facility addition project for the Central Peninsula General Hospital.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to utilize these funds for the construction of the above CT-Scan Addition project, and all expenditures will be charged against the project account.

Section 3. That unused portions of funds appropriated for this project shall be returned to the Central Peninsula General Hospital's unappropriated capital funds account upon completion of the project.

Section 4. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with the award of a construction contract for the CT-Scan Facility.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
