## ORDINANCE 90-57

AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SAND MATERIAL FROM AN EXISTING MATERIAL PIT LOCATED ON BOROUGH LANDS TO NORRIS AND SONS

WHEREAS, the Borough has selected and received final approval to state-patented lands in the Cooper Landing area described as Section 35, Township 5 North, Range 3 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, a portion of those lands contain an established material site that the Borough currently has issued small quantity negotiated material permits under 17.04.210; and

WHEREAS, application has been received from Norris and Sons for material to be supplied under contract to the State Department of Highways for this winter's sanding operations; and

WHEREAS, the Borough finds that it is in its best interest to provide, by sale, material for the winter sanding operations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Borough may sell up to 2,500 cubic yards of sand at the price of \$1.50 per cubic yard from that existing material pit located at Mile 1.8 Snug Harbor Road within the N1/2 SW1/4 Section 35, Township 5 North, Range 3 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska to Norris and Sons.

<u>Section 2</u>. That authorized material must be delivered to the State of Alaska, Department of Highways for their winter sanding operations.

<u>Section 3</u>. That the Mayor is authorized to sign such documents necessary to effectuate this sale.

<u>Section 4</u>. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment, with material extraction, equipment removal and site cleanup to be completed by December 31, 1990.
