KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 90-72

AUTHORIZING THE REPLACEMENT OF THE UNISYS A-9F MAINFRAME COMPUTER WITH THE PURCHASE OF A UNISYS A-6NSU COMPUTER

WHEREAS, the borough's A-9F mainframe computer has exceeded its optimal processing capacity; and

WHEREAS, its age and size are resulting in increasing maintenance and operating software costs; and

WHEREAS, Unisys now offers an A-6NSU which has increased processing capabilities over the A-9F and will result in lower costs; and

WHEREAS, sole sourcing with Unisys will allow current applications software and remote terminals to continue to be used with no transitional hardware, software, or staff retraining costs involved; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of A-6NSU hardware is \$760,654.95 and operating software licensing for five years is \$226,086.40; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the current data processing division budget and the equipment replacement fund;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That \$760,654.95 is appropriated from the equipment replacement fund to purchase a Unisys A-6NSU with associated hardware.


Section 2. That the mayor is authorized to execute an agreement to license and lease operating software for the A-6NSU.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
