ORDINANCE 90-73

INCREASING THE TOTAL BUDGET AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR FISCAL YEAR 1990/91 BY \$1,688,369

WHEREAS, Ordinance 90-27 appropriated up to \$18,460,156 for the school district budget for the FY 1990/91; and

WHEREAS, the actual portion of that appropriation that may be expended cannot exceed the difference between \$61,297,325, the approved total for the school district budget, and all revenues of the district from other sources; and

WHEREAS, the school district anticipates receiving additional funds from the state foundation and state grant programs in funding the amount of \$1,688,369; and

WHEREAS, the limits of Ordinance 90-27 need to be changed to increase the total operating budget amount to allow the school district to use these funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the total budget amount for the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District contained in Section 2 of Ordinance 90-27 is increased by \$1,688,369. The Kenai Peninsula Borough School District is authorized to spend up to the new total of \$62,985,694, subject to the limitation of the \$18,460,156 Local Effort amount specified in that ordinance and availability of funds.

<u>Section 2</u>. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
