KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 91-14

AMENDING KPB 5.22.050 TO ALLOW FUNDING FOR SERVICES TO SENIOR CITIZENS WITHIN A PARTICULAR PRECINCT TO BE ALLOCATED TO THE ORGANIZATION SERVING SENIOR CITIZENS IN THAT PRECINCT IF MORE THAN ONE ORGANIZATION PROVIDES SERVICES IN THE PRECINCT

WHEREAS, KPB 5.22.050 does not allow more than one senior citizens organization serving a precinct to be funded under the borough program; and

WHEREAS, the geography and population of the Peninsula virtually dictates that some precincts will be served by more than one senior citizens organization; and

WHEREAS, restriction to one organization per precinct may cause unnecessary and artificial changes in funding if precinct boundaries change;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That KPB 5.22.050 is amended to read:

5.22.050 Population counts. For the purposes of grant allocations made under this chapter, the number of persons within each organization is based on the number of individuals over 60 years old counted within the election precincts being served by the organization, in the 1984 special census or upon the latest census that has a count of individuals over 60 years of age. If more than one organization serves all or a portion of the senior citizens population within a precinct the assembly may determine the number of persons served by each organization. [NO MORE THAN ONE ORGANIZATION OR GROUP PER ELECTION PRECINCT WILL BE FUNDED UNDER THIS CHAPTER.]

Section 2. That this ordinance shall in no way alter funding distribution for Fiscal Year 1990-91.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
