ORDINANCE 91-19

APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES FOR FISCAL YEAR 1991-92

WHEREAS, the Assembly is required by Alaska Statute 14.14.060(c) to make an appropriation for the local share of funding for the school budget by May 31; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 91-43 approved a total school budget of \$72,608,622 and established that up to \$25,843,214 be provided from local sources (\$19,814,398 local effort and \$6,028,816 in-kind services) for school purposes;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That subject to the provisions of this ordinance, the following is appropriated to the school fund from local sources for school operations purposes and in-kind services for the fiscal year July 1, 1991 through June 30, 1992:

A.	Local Effort	\$19,814,398
B.	Borough Maintenance	4,510,495
C.	School District Utilities	48,340
D.	Insurance	1,440,681
E.	Audit	29,300
Total Local Sources		<u>\$25,843,214</u>


Section 2. That disbursements from the direct appropriation in Section 1 item (A) shall be made only as needed to supplement other revenues available and received by the school district to fund the school district operations portion of the budget of \$66,579,806.

Section 3. That this ordinance takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on July 1, 1991.
