## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 91-29

AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF BOROUGH LANDS DESCRIBED AS TRACT A FISHERMEN ROADS SUBDIVISION TO WILLIAM J. NELSON

WHEREAS, the borough has title to Tract A, Fishermen Roads Subdivision; and,

WHEREAS, application has been received from William J. Nelson to lease or purchase said property; and,

WHEREAS, requests for review and comment were sent to the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District, Assessing Department, Public Works Department, Emergency Management, Kalifornsky Beach Fire Service Area, Central Peninsula Emergency Medical Service Area, Central Peninsula Hospital Service Area and Central Peninsula Road Service Area; and,

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Public Works Department responded to the request for comments with no objection; and,
