KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

ORDINANCE 91-39

AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF VARIOUS GRANTS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION, AND APPROPRIATING \$3,893,000 TO PROJECT ACCOUNTS

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has appropriated \$3,893,000 for grants to the Kenai Peninsula Borough for various projects within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, \$40,000 is allocated for the purpose of purchasing and installing siding for the Moose Pass School; and

WHEREAS, \$8,000 is allocated for the purpose of Moose Pass School carpeting; and

WHEREAS, \$50,000 is allocated for the purpose of renovations as Nikiski Fire Station No. 1; and

WHEREAS, \$45,000 is allocated for the purpose of upgrades at Nikiski Fire Station No. 2; and

WHEREAS, \$100,000 is allocated for the purpose of the Seward Bear Creek Fire Tanker Replacement; and

WHEREAS, \$300,000 is allocated for the purpose of purchasing and installing an enhanced 911 emergency system; and

WHEREAS, \$100,000 is allocated for the purpose of the Seward enhanced 911 emergency system; and

WHEREAS, \$900,000 is allocated for the purpose of Knight Drive construction; and

WHEREAS, \$1,000,000 is allocated for the purpose of West Poppy Lane Construction; and

WHEREAS, \$900,000 is allocated for the purpose of Ciechanski Road right of way and construction; and

WHEREAS, \$200,000 is allocated for the purpose of the North Fork Road design and right of way; and

WHEREAS, \$100,000 is allocated for the purpose of the Anchor Point Beach Access Road reconstruction; and

WHEREAS, \$50,000 is allocated to the South Peninsula Road Service Area for maintenance and upgrades; and

WHEREAS, \$100,000 is allocated to the Central Peninsula Road Service Area for maintenance and upgrades;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1: That the Mayor is authorized to accept these grants for projects made by the Alaska Legislature in Ch.96 SLA 1991 totalling \$3,893,000.




Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
