ORDINANCE 91-50

**ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT FROM THE ALASKA
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES FOR
DEVELOPMENT OF A COMPREHENSIVE TRAIL PLAN FOR THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH**

WHEREAS, the Alaska Legislature under Chapter 96/SLA 91 appropriated funds for the development of a comprehensive trail plan for the Kenai Peninsula Borough consistent with the requirements of the State of Alaska and the Federal Highway Administration; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities has offered a transfer of responsibilities agreement to the Borough to accomplish the trail plan development, and

WHEREAS, the grant amount of \$10,000 needs to be appropriated to accomplish the task;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1: That the Mayor is authorized to accept the grant from the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities and to sign the transfer of responsibilities agreement.

Section 2: That a temporary employee be hired to develop this plan only for the life of the agreement, not to exceed March 30, 1992.

Section 3: That an appropriation be made to a new division, Comprehensive Trail Plan, in the Planning Grants Fund as follows:


Section 4: That this ordinance take effect immediately upon its enactment.
