## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 91-51

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING KPB SECTION 5.12.080 (B) CHANGING LATE PAYMENT PENALTY PROVISIONS

WHEREAS, there is a 10% penalty levied on late payments of property taxes stipulated by Borough code Section 5.12.080 (B); and

WHEREAS, this rate of penalty represents an exorbitant interest rate which works an unreasonable hardship on late payers; and

WHEREAS, calculation of the penalty in two installments will encourage timely payment at the second half due date even if the first half payment was not made,

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1: That Section 5.12.080 (B) be repealed and reenacted to read:

- B. Penalties and Interest shall accrue as follows
  - 1. If any portion of the first half installment is not paid when due the unpaid balance of the installment is delinquent and penalty and interest accrue on the delinquent tax balance from the due date until paid.
  - 2. If any portion of the second half installment is not paid when due the unpaid balance of the installment is delinquent and penalty and interest accrue on the delinquent tax balance from the due date until paid.
  - 3. The penalty shall be 10 percent of the delinquent tax and is levied on the first day of delinquency. Interest shall accrue at the rate of 12% per annum calculated on the delinquent tax amount.

Section 3: That this ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 1992.
