**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE 92-11**

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE FINAL ADOPTION  
OF THE PORT GRAHAM/ENGLISH BAY  
AREA WHICH MERITS SPECIAL ATTENTION AS AN ADDITION  
TO THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH COASTAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAM**

- WHEREAS,** the Kenai Peninsula Borough is a Coastal District within the Alaska Coastal Management Program; and
- WHEREAS,** the Kenai Peninsula Borough Coastal Management Program, adopted in June of 1990, recommended the development of an Area Which Merits Special Attention Plan for the Port Graham/English Bay area; and
- WHEREAS,** the Port Graham/English Bay AMSA Plan is designed to protect and preserve natural resources, habitats, and the traditional subsistence culture and lifestyles that exist on the southwestern Kenai Peninsula while allowing planned development to occur; and
- WHEREAS,** the Village Councils of Port Graham and English Bay have each adopted resolutions in support of the Borough's efforts to create the Port Graham/English Bay AMSA plan; and
- WHEREAS** the Planning Commission passed resolution 90-17 on August 6, 1990 recommending approval; and
- WHEREAS,** the Borough Assembly gave concept approval to the AMSA Plan through Resolution 91-71 on June 4, 1991; and
- WHEREAS,** the Alaska Coastal Policy Council approved the final Port Graham/English Bay AMSA Plan with changes recommended by the Division of Governmental Coordination for incorporation into the Alaska Coastal Management Program on October 31, 1991; and
- WHEREAS,** the AMSA Plan received federal approval from the Office of Ocean and Coastal Resource Management on December 17, 1991 establishing routine program implementation and its incorporation into ACMP pursuant to 15 C.F.R. §923.84; and


**WHEREAS**, the AMSA Plan will give the Port Graham and English Bay Village Councils additional opportunity to review, comment, and approve future development projects which may have an impact on coastal resources within the AMSA; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**


**Section 1.** That the Port Graham/English Bay AMSA be officially adopted as an addition to the Kenai Peninsula Borough Coastal Management Program.

**Section 2.** That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
