KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 92-32

AN ORDINANCE CLASSIFYING CERTAIN BOROUGH OWNED LANDS FOR SALE

- WHEREAS, the borough has received by quit-claim deed, prior to the real property tax foreclosure, that portion of the NW¹/₄SE¹/₄ lying north of the Sterling Highway within Section 7, T1S, R13W, S.M., Alaska; and
- WHEREAS, the above property is subject to a public right-of-way easement along the westerly 60 feet thereof; and
- WHEREAS, application has been received from Aurora Communications International, Inc. for the purchase of \pm 1.23 acres for the construction of a private road and placement of a caretaker's cottage; and
- WHEREAS, the applicant owns the adjoining \pm 150 acres to the north of the borough's property; and
- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission considered this matter at their regular meeting of May 4, 1992 and recommended the sale as described be approved;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That the following described lands are hereby classified for disposal to sell to Aurora Communications International, Inc.: A portion of the NW¼SE¼ lying north of the Sterling Highway within Section 7, T1S, R13W, S.M., Alaska, containing 1.3 acres, more or less, subject to the submittal, approval and filing of a plat in accordance with the subdivision ordinance and the sale price shall be the fair market value as established by the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assessor.
- **SECTION 2.** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
- **SECTION 3.** That the Mayor is authorized to sign such documents necessary to effectuate this sale.
