KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 92-45

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF VARIOUS GRANTS FROM
THE STATE OF ALASKA AND APPROPRIATING \$1,506,900 TO CAPITAL
PROJECT ACCOUNTS**

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has appropriated \$1,506,900 for grants to the Kenai Peninsula Borough for various capital projects within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, \$800,000 is allocated for the purpose of the design and construction of a Kenai/Nikiski solid waste transfer site; and

WHEREAS, \$150,000 is allocated for the purpose of road improvements by the Road Maintenance Service Area; and

WHEREAS, \$100,000 is allocated for an auxiliary generator for Central Peninsula General Hospital; and

WHEREAS, \$50,000 is allocated for renovations to the dietary department at South Peninsula Hospital; and

WHEREAS, \$20,000 is allocated for roof repairs to the Bear Creek Fire Station;

WHEREAS, \$386,900 is allocated for various school projects, and the School Board, during their regular meeting on August 10, 1992, requested that the Assembly accept the following grants:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to accept these grants for various capital projects in the total amount of \$1,506,900 appropriated by the Alaska Legislature in Chapter 5 SLA 1992.




