AN ORDINANCE AMENDING KPB 5.28.210 SOLICITATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF BIDS

- WHEREAS, recent bid offerings have been advertised in a newspaper circulated in the Central Peninsula and an Anchorage newspaper; and
- WHEREAS, these publications are not necessarily read by business owners in the Homer and Seward areas; and
- WHEREAS, all borough business owners should be afforded notice of and the opportunity to bid on borough projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That KPB 5.28.210 is amended to read:

5.28.210. Solicitation and acceptance of bids.

A. ...

B. Public notice of the invitation for bids shall be published at least once in the [A] newspapers of general circulation in the Borough at least 10 days before the last day on which bids will be accepted. The Mayor shall determine whether the services or products sought by each individual contract are of a type available from businesses located within the Borough, and shall cause additional publication of the invitation for bids within each region of the Borough where such availability has been determined to exist. Such notice shall also be posted at the office of the purchasing officer. The contents of the notice shall be sufficient to inform interested readers of the general nature of the supplies, services or construction being procured and the procedure for submitting a bid.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
