KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 93-24

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND APPROPRIATING A NATURAL RESOURCE CONSERVATION EDUCATION GRANT FORM THE UNITED STATES FOREST SERVICE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,820

- WHEREAS, a proposal was submitted to the U.S. Forest Service for a grant through their Natural Resources Conservation Education Program; and
- WHEREAS, notice has been received that the grant has been selected for funding and that a formal application should be submitted; and
- WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used for the construction of a pictorial exhibit to educate students and the general public as to the current spruce bark beetle infestation on the Kenai Peninsula;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with the grant application process and to accept the grant funds from the United States Forest Service.
- **SECTION 2.** That grant funds in the amount of \$2,820 are appropriated to account No. 100-115010-42320 for construction of visual panels to be used for a public awareness campaign on spruce bark beetle infestation.
