**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE 93-24**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND APPROPRIATING A NATURAL  
RESOURCE CONSERVATION EDUCATION GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES  
FOREST SERVICE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,820**

**WHEREAS,** a proposal was submitted to the U.S. Forest Service for a grant through their Natural Resources Conservation Education Program; and

**WHEREAS,** notice has been received that the grant has been selected for funding and that a formal application should be submitted; and

**WHEREAS,** the grant funds will be used for the construction of a pictorial exhibit to educate students and the general public as to the current spruce bark beetle infestation on the Kenai Peninsula;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with the grant application process and to accept the grant funds from the United States Forest Service.


