**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE 93-39**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF VARIOUS GRANTS FROM  
THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION, AND  
APPROPRIATING \$1,314,600 TO CAPITAL PROJECT ACCOUNTS**

- WHEREAS,** the State of Alaska has appropriated \$1,314,600 for grants to be administered by the Alaska Department of Administration under AS 37.05.315-.325 for various capital projects within the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and
- WHEREAS,** \$60,000 is allocated for the purpose of refurbishing and purchasing equipment by the Bear Creek Fire Service Area; and
- WHEREAS,** \$290,500 is allocated for the purpose of construction of a fire station for the Central Emergency Service Area; and
- WHEREAS,** \$50,000 is allocated for a rescue truck for the Nikiski Fire Service Area; and
- WHEREAS,** \$30,000 is allocated for pool repairs for the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area; and
- WHEREAS,** \$200,000 is allocated for renovations to the dietary department at South Peninsula Hospital; and
- WHEREAS,** \$25,000 is allocated for erosion control and a boat ramp on Lowell Point Road; and
- WHEREAS,** \$200,000 is allocated for pedestrian and vehicle safety improvement in Ninilchik; and
- WHEREAS,** \$15,000 is allocated for a safety path extension in Moose Pass; and
- WHEREAS,** \$40,000 is allocated for road and trail improvements in Cooper Landing; and
- WHEREAS,** \$20,000 is allocated for upgrading the access road to Gray Cliff Subdivision; and
- WHEREAS,** \$50,000 is allocated for construction of the Nikiski Senior Center; and

**WHEREAS, \$25,000 is allocated for fire safety equipment at the Ninilchik Harbor; and**

**WHEREAS, \$35,000 is allocated for a revolving capital loan fund to be administered by the Economic Development District, Inc.; and**

**WHEREAS, \$146,000 is allocated for various school projects as follows:**

Kenai Middle School - library acquisitions	5,000
Mountain View Elementary School -computer conversion	5,000
Nikiski Elementary School - computer technology grant	16,000

**WHEREAS, the unexpended and unobligated balance of \$128,100 has been repealed from school projects at Paul Banks Elementary School, Chapman Elementary School, and Ninilchik Elementary/High School and is reappropriated for school projects as follows:**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is authorized to accept grants for various capital projects in the total amount of \$1,314,600 as appropriated by the Alaska Legislature in Chapter 79 SLA 1993 (\$1,186,500), and in Chapter 41 SLA 1993 (\$128,100).


