## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 94-15

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT OF A MATCHING GRANT FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,822,100 AND APPROPRIATING \$5,462,100 FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE TUSTUMENA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADDITION

WHEREAS, the voters of the Kenai Peninsula Borough approved the sale of \$1,640,000 in bonds to finance the Tustumena Elementary School Addition; and

- WHEREAS, the legislature, through passage of Senate Bill 7 during the 1993 legislative session, established a major maintenance matching grant program for funding various school projects; and
- WHEREAS, Senate Bill 60, passed during the 1993 legislative session, appropriated \$3,822,100 as the State's 70% share of the Tustumena Elementary School Addition; and
- WHEREAS, the local share requirement is based on the taxable value of real and personal property; and following the required formula, the Borough's local share percentage is 30% or \$1,640,000; and
- WHEREAS, the Assembly is required to appropriate both the State's 70% share and the local 30% share; and
- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough deems it in the best interest of the public to participate in the State's major matching grant program;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to accept the capital project grant in the total amount of \$3,822,100 as appropriated by the Alaska Legislature in Chapter 83 SLA 1993.
- SECTION 2. That the following sums are hereby appropriated to the following accounts:

401-711300-49999-M0994 Grant from DOE \$3,822,100 401-711300-49999-M0994 Bond funds for match \$1,640,000

SECTION 3. That per the conditions of Ordinance 93-30 and Ordinance 93-57, \$566,000 of the bond funds are returned to the general fund.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
