KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 94-20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING KPB 5.35 RELATING TO UTILITY SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICTS

- WHEREAS, at the Borough Regular Election of October 1991, the voters approved a ballot proposition which authorized formation of special assessment districts to provide for the extension of utility lines in the area outside of the cities; and
- WHEREAS, to carry out the will of the voters Ordinance 92-16 was adopted by the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly on April 7, 1992, which put procedures into place to the formation of utility special assessment districts; and
- WHEREAS, Ordinance 92-16 provided that special assessments may be utilized solely for financing of the extension of the lines of service of those public utilities regulated by the Alaska Public Utilities Commission; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the residents of the Kenai Peninsula Borough to also allow for financing of the extension of the lines of service of those public utilities owned and operated by a municipal government;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:

SECTION 1. That Section 5.35.020 is amended as follows:

5.35.020. Authorized capital improvements.

Special Assessments may be utilized solely for financing of the extension of the lines of service of those public utilities regulated by the Alaska Public Utilities Commission or the extension of lines of city owned utilities to areas outside the boundaries of the city.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
