KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 94-46

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION, FOR AN EMERGENCY SIREN AT NORTH STAR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

- WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature repealed the unexpended and unobligated balance of \$10,384.67 from a grant for school zone flashing lights at Nikiski Elementary School and reappropriated the funds for an electronic warning siren at North Star Elementary School;
- WHEREAS, notice has been received of the award of this grant which is to be administered by the Alaska Department of Administration under AS 37.05.315-.325; and
- WHEREAS, this project was included in the Borough's 1994 list of legislative priorities and is endorsed by the Nikiski community and the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to accept a grant for purchase and installation of an electronic warning siren to be located at North Star Elementary School in the amount of \$10,384.67, as appropriated by the Alaska Legislature in Ch. 8 FSSLA 1994 (SCSCS HB 441 (FIN) AMS).
- SECTION 2. That these grant funds are appropriated to the following Borough account: 400-710801-49999-95001.
- **SECTION 3.** That these grant funds shall be utilized to carry out the purpose of the grant, under the terms and conditions specified in the grant agreement, and that the Borough accepts responsibility for operation and maintenance of facilities constructed with these funds.
- SECTION 4. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
