**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 95-37**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE SUNSET PROVISION IN ORDINANCE 94-59
REGARDING SALES TAXES ON LONG-TERM VEHICLE LEASES**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 94-59 amended the sales tax code to treat long-term vehicle leases as one taxable transaction per year, with a provision terminating the amendment on December 31, 1995 unless the assembly by ordinance alters that date; and

WHEREAS, the assembly finds that the borough's best interests would be served by allowing the amendment to remain in effect indefinitely;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the sunset provision terminating changes to the sales tax code in Ordinance 94-59 on December 31, 1995 is hereby repealed, and all such changes shall continue in effect without interruption.


SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
