**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 96-01**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING KPB 4.120.050, ELECTIONS BY MAIL,
NOTIFICATION TO VOTERS**

WHEREAS, KPB Code currently requires the mailing of notification of special election to each registered voter prior to the mailing of ballots; and

WHEREAS, other jurisdictions which are using the by-mail method of voting on a regular basis do not send notification to voters; and

WHEREAS, elimination of this requirement would greatly reduce the cost of the election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That Section 4.120.050, Notification to voters, is hereby repealed.


SECTION 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon enactment.
