AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TWO YEAR SCHOOL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND LAPSING BALANCES ON COMPLETED PROJECTS TO THE GENERAL FUND

- WHEREAS, the construction season is short and projects need to be bid ready at the beginning of the construction season; and
- WHEREAS, the standard budget process does not make funds available until the beginning of a fiscal year which is well into the construction season; and
- WHEREAS, a two year capital improvements program which addresses deferred maintenance projects and other major school capital projects is advantageous for both planning and funding purposes; and
- **WHEREAS,** a number of projects were completed under budget and the balances are available for reappropriation;
