KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 96-15

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES FOR FISCAL YEAR 1996-97

- WHEREAS, the Assembly is required by Alaska Statute 14.14.060(c) to make an appropriation for the local share of funding for the school budget by June 30; and
- WHEREAS, Resolution 96-33 approved a total school budget of \$81,801,474 and established that up to \$27,630,077 be provided from local sources (\$21,722,888 local effort and \$5,907,189 in-kind services) for school purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That subject to the provisions of this ordinance, the following is appropriated to the school fund from local sources for school operations purposes and in-kind services for the year July 1, 1996 through June 30, 1997:

A.	Local Effort	\$21,722,888
В.	Borough Maintenance	4,764,331
C.	School District Utilities	37,707
D.	Insurance	1,006,278
E.	Audit	25,000
F.	Custodial Services	73,873

Total Local Sources \$27,630,077

SECTION 2. That disbursements from the direct appropriation in Section 1 item (A) shall be made only as needed to supplement other revenues available and received by the school district to fund the school district operations portion of the budget.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on July 1, 1996.
