**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 96-23**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING RECEIPT OF A GRANT FROM THE ALASKA
DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND REGIONAL AFFAIRS FOR A SENIOR
CITIZENS CENTER IN ANCHOR POINT, AND APPROPRIATING THE GRANT
AWARD AMOUNT PLUS MATCHING CONTRIBUTIONS**

WHEREAS, through adoption of Resolution 95-76, the Mayor was authorized to submit a cooperative application to the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs ("DCRA") for a grant up to \$200,000 under the Community Development Block Grant Program ("CDBG") for funding the construction of a senior citizens center in Anchor Point; and

WHEREAS, notification has been received from DCRA that the Borough has been awarded a grant under the CDBG program; and

WHEREAS, since it is desirable to complete construction of the senior citizens center during the 1996 construction season a shortened hearing date is requested for this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Anchor Point Senior Citizens, Inc. ("APSCI") has agreed to provide all matching cash or in-kind contributions necessary for grant award and compliance and will reserve these matching funds until the project is completed; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of construction, APSCI will have sole responsibility for operation and maintenance of the senior citizens center;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to execute a grant agreement and related documents in order to accept CDBG funds in an amount up to \$200,000 for construction of a senior citizens center in Anchor Point.

SECTION 2. That any matching requirements will be satisfied through cash or in-kind contributions from the Anchor Point Senior Citizens, Inc.

SECTION 3. That the amount of the grant award, not to exceed \$200,000, plus any amounts received from APSCI are hereby appropriated.


SECTION 4. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
