KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH **ORDINANCE 96-27**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDS FROM ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY SERVICES (ADES) AND FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA)

- WHEREAS, the flooding which occurred on the Kenai Peninsula in 1995 damaged several publicly owned facilities, primarily roads and bridges; and
- WHEREAS, following disaster declarations by the Borough, the State of Alaska, and the United States of America, certain repairs have been approved by FEMA; and
- WHEREAS, the cost of these repairs, estimated to be \$174,644, will be paid by FEMA (75) percent) and ADES (25 percent) through a reimbursement grant; and
- WHEREAS, shortened hearing is requested because timing is critical to the completion of these projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is authorized to receive disaster relief funds from ADES and FEMA.
- **SECTION 2.** That the repair work approved by FEMA with Damage Survey Reports (DSRs) numbered 49771, 58026, 49793, 36555, 36556, 49764, 49789, and 49790 is hereby authorized to be completed. The appropriation of \$174,644 and expenditures for each project shall be separately accounted for in the Disaster Relief Fund.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
