## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 97-09

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING KPB 22.40.130, AGENDA, PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough extends some 165 miles by road from Seward to Homer; and

WHEREAS, because of this distance, weather, and time factors, borough residents at each end of the Peninsula are often deterred from testifying before the Assembly; and

**WHEREAS,** it is in the best interest of the KPB Assembly to get as much input from all readers across the borough;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

**SECTION 1.** That KPB 22.40.130.A. is amended to read:

A. Public testimony ......... At the request of an assembly member, with one week prior notice before an assembly meeting, teleconferencing may be set up from areas over 50 miles from the borough building on Binkley Avenue in Soldotna. The agenda item of which the public wishes to testify will be specific and be limited to the same rules applied in this section. Arrangements for the teleconference will be made by the Borough Clerk.

**SECTION 2.** That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon enactment.
