KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 98-43

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE 15 PERCENT CASH DISCOUNT FOR THE SALE OF CERTAIN PARCELS OF BOROUGH OWNED LAND

- WHEREAS, Ordinance 97-36 authorized the sale of numerous lots within Gray Cliff and Moose Point Subdivisions in an ongoing, year to year, over-the-counter market value sale, and authorized a 15 percent discount for cash sales of such property; and
- WHEREAS, Ordinance 98-27 reauthorized most such parcels for sale and added more parcels in the same areas, but eliminated the 15 percent cash discount for those sales; and
- WHEREAS, offering the 15 percent cash discount encourages purchasers to pay cash which eliminates the expense and risks to the borough associated with borough-financed sales; and
- **WHEREAS,** numerous borough residents have requested that the assembly reinstate the 15 percent cash discount for these parcels;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That in addition to the terms and conditions included in Ordinance 98-27, if a purchaser of any parcel authorized for sale in Ordinance 98-27 elects to pay a lump sum cash amount for the parcel, a 15 percent discount shall be applied to the sale price of that parcel.
- **SECTION 2.** The mayor is authorized to sign any documents necessary to effectuate this ordinance.
- SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
