#### KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 98-54

#### AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$117,682.21 TO THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT FUND FOR ISLAND LAKE/MOOSE RUN NATURAL GAS LINE UTILITY SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

- WHEREAS, KPB 5.35 provides authority for creating and financing utility special assessment districts for utility line extension; and
- WHEREAS, a petition has been received requesting the formation of a special assessment district in the Island Lake/Moose Run area for construction of a natural gas mainline; and
- WHEREAS, the assembly adopted a resolution of necessity for the Island Lake/Moose Run Utility Special Assessment District and has adopted a resolution to proceed with construction; and
- WHEREAS, financing is necessary to complete the administrative requirements of the ordinance and regulations; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to KPB 5.10.040(A)(11) the borough may invest in special assessment districts; and
- WHEREAS, the estimated total cost of the project of \$117,682.21 is to be provided as an investment by the general fund which will be repaid with interest by assessments on the parcels within the district and;
- WHEREAS, hearing on shortened time is justified in order that the gas line be constructed within this construction season which will provide the residents within the USAD a safe, economical, clean source of heat this winter.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the amount of \$117,682.21 is authorized to be advanced to the assessment fund from the general fund and appropriated into Account No. 874-920014-49999-ILAKE.

SECTION 2. That the special assessment fund shall repay the full amount with interest to the general fund through payments made on the special assessments levied.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.

That the Kenai Peninsula Borough hereby accepts a grant of \$731,658, including \$548,744 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency and \$182,914 from the State of Alaska Division of Emergency Services, and appropriates it to the Kenai Peninsula Borough's Environmental Protection Fund, account 262-112070-49999-99HMG, for Resurrection River Hazard Mitigation Projects.
- **SECTION 2.** That the Kenai Peninsula Borough appropriates \$20,000 from the general fund balance to the Office of Emergency Management operating budget, account 100-112050-43011-99262, to address mitigation issues throughout the borough, including maintenance of the Resurrection River area, to its post-project configuration, annually, or on an as-needed basis.
- **SECTION 3.** That the Mayor is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this ordinance deemed to be in the best interest of the Borough.
- **SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
