AN ORDINANCE REDIRECTING UNEXPENDED BOND FUNDS, LAPSING BALANCES ON COMPLETED PROJECTS TO THE GENERAL FUND AND APPROPRIATING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FOR SCHOOL CAPITAL MAINTENANCE PROJECTS

- **WHEREAS,** a number of previously appropriated projects have been completed under budget and the balances are available for reappropriation; and
- WHEREAS, on October 7, 1997, Borough voters authorized the redirection of available West Homer Elementary School bond funds to other school capital improvement projects; and
- WHEREAS, surplus bond funds from previously authorized and completed Ninilchik School projects are available for redirection; and
- WHEREAS, the borough and school district administrations have worked together to identify and prioritize a list of school capital maintenance projects that should be completed as soon as possible; and
- WHEREAS, continued deferral of these projects will result in higher than normal maintenance related operating expenditures and eventually in higher than normal capital maintenance expenditures; and
- WHEREAS, appropriating funding for these projects at this time will allow for their completion during the 1999 construction season.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the unencumbered balances on the following projects be lapsed to the fund balance of the General Fund:
